[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

On August 21, 2018, the defendant, Stephanie Cahn, violated F.S.S. 812.135(2)(a) Principal to Home Invasion Robbery with a Deadly Weapon and F.S.S. 782.04 Accessory After The Fact to Attempted Homicide, and F.S.S. 777.03(1) Accessory After the Fact by conspiring with the co-defendant to rob the victim, A. Morris, at his residence, 244 Kathy Court, Mary Esther, Florida Morris was bound and stabbed multiple times and robbed of \$600.00 in US currency.

Investigators made contact with Morris after he recovered from emergency surgery in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU). Morris advised he returned home from work and observed his Silver Hyundai Sonata parked in the driveway of his residence. He stated his girlfriend, Stephanie Cahn/DEFENDANT, typically drove the vehicle but had not that day due to the vehicle having mechanical issues. Morris said he unlocked his front door and was immediately attacked by the male co-defendant (Roger Coleman III), who he has personally known for approximately one (1) month, when he entered his

residence. Morris stated the male co-defendant stabbed him multiple times with a "pocket knife" and bound his arms and legs. Morris advised the male co-defendant removed his wallet, cell phone, and car keys from his pants pockets looking for money. Morris said the male co-defendant took \$600.00 in US currency from his wallet.

Co-defendant Rogerie Coleman advised post Miranda, he and Cahn conspired to leave the state and needed money to travel north. Coleman stated Cahn was upset with Morris/VICTIM because he was an abusive boyfriend and stated they could take his narcotics and money. Coleman said Cahn gave him the keys to the Silver Sonata and keys to the apartment she shared with Morris. Coleman said Cahn called Morris to determine he had his cash on his person and to see what time he would be home from work so Coleman could be waiting inside the apartment. Coleman advised he attacked Morris once he entered the residence and stabbed him several times during the struggle. Coleman admitted to binding Morris' arms and legs with shredded towels and covering him with a blanket. Coleman said he took Morris' wallet that contained \$600.00 and gave the wallet and money to Cahn. Coleman advised he and Cahn fled the state the following day. Coleman advised when he told Cahn what he did to Morris, Cahn said Morris got what "he deserved".

Defendant, Stephanie Cahn, advised post Miranda, she and co-defendant, Rogerie Coleman III, conspired to leave the state and travel north. Cahn said she was leaving victim, A. Morris, because he was an abusive boyfriend. Cahn stated she told Coleman where Morris keeps his narcotics and allowed Coleman to take the narcotics while the two of them were inside the apartment, together, earlier in the day. Cahn advised she had seen Morris with a large stack of money the previous day. Cahn stated she and Coleman looked for the money inside the apartment but did not find it. Cahn advised she knows all of Morris' "hiding spots" therefore the money must be with Morris. Cahn advised she informed Morris that she was not going to drive the Sonata to work because the engine was having issues and made arrangements for her mother to drive her. Cahn did this so it would not be suspicious to Morris when he saw the Sonata in the driveway upon returning home from work. Cahn stated she received a text message from Morris around 4pm stating he would be leaving work in about thirty (30) minutes. Based on this information, Cahn stated she began to "panic" and knew she had to hurry. Cahn told Coleman when Morris would be home from work, provided Coleman with the key to the Sonata, and told him when he needed to drive the Sonata back to the apartment. Cahn did this so Coleman would be inside the apartment and waiting for Morris when Morris returned home from work so Coleman could take Morris' money. Cahn stated Coleman later told her he stabbed Morris during the course of robbing him and taking his money. Cahn advised she and Coleman fled the state the following day in a different vehicle leaving the Sonata at an unknown location to Morris.

The defendant, Stephanie Cahn, conspired and facilitated these crimes by providing Coleman with transportation to the house, via the Hyundai Sonata, and access to the apartment, via the apartment key. Cahn also told Coleman when Morris would be home from work so he would be inside the residence prior to Morris' arrival.

Based on the above facts I have reason to believe and do believe the defendant, STEPHANIE LISHON CAHN, violated F.S.S. 812.135 (2)(a) Principal to Home Invasion Robbery with a Deadly Weapon, F.S.S. 782.04 Accessory After The Fact to Attempted Homicide, and F.S.S. 777.03(1) Accessory After the Fact. The defendant conspired with co-defendant, Rogerie Coleman III, to commit the Robbery and during the course of the robbery, the victim was stabbed approximately five (5) times. These violations occurred in Okaloosa County, Florida where I am a sworn law enforcement officer.

On August 21, 2018, at approximately 1830 hours, the defendant Rogerie Ellis Coleman III, violated F.S.S. 782.04 Attempted Homicide and F.S.S. 812.135 (2)(a) Home Invasion Robbery with a Deadly Weapon by entering the victim's, A Morris, residence, 244 Kathy Court, Mary Esther, Florida without permission with the intent of robbing Morris of his

personal property and stabbing Morris multiple times after binding him with shredded towels.

Investigators made contact with Morris after he recovered from emergency surgery in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU). Morris advised in a sworn verbal statement, he returned home from work and observed his Silver Hyundai Sonata parked in the driveway of his residence. He stated his girlfriend, Stephanie Cahn/co-defendant, typically drove the vehicle but had not that day due to the vehicle having mechanical issues. Morris said he unlocked his front door and was immediately attacked by the male defendant (Roger Coleman III), who he has personally known for approximately one (1) month, when he entered his residence. Morris stated Coleman stabbed him multiple times in the trunk of the body with a "pocket knife" and left him on the floor of the entry way of the residence covered by a blanket with his arms and legs bound. Morris stated Coleman removed his wallet, cell phone, and keys, from his pants pockets while asking Morris where his money was located. Morris stated he was able to escape to the neighbor's residence while the defendant was rummaging through the upstairs bedroom.

M. Holloway, who was identified as Morris' neighbor, advised she had observed the Silver Sonata in the Morris' driveway earlier that day. She stated she saw a silver vehicle believed to be the Sonata leave the victim's driveway immediately after Morris came to her apartment for help.

The defendant, Roger Coleman III, advised post Miranda he and the co-defendant, Stephanie Cahn, who was Morris' girlfriend, conspired to leave the state and needed money to travel so they decided to rob Morris of his narcotics and US currency. Coleman advised he traveled to Morris' residence in the Silver Sonata, which was being driven by Cahn, and entered the apartment with a key provided by Cahn. Coleman said he cut up dish towels to bind Morris while waiting in the apartment. He said once Morris came home, Coleman attacked him in the entryway/stairwell. Coleman said he stabbed Morris during the struggle with a small pocket knife and removed the victim's wallet looking for money. Coleman advised he got \$600.00 in US currency from the victim's wallet that was later given to the co-defendant, Cahn. Coleman said he fled the residence in the Silver Sonata and met with the co-defendant to leave the state the following day. Coleman admitted he was still in possession of the knife used to stab Morris and had not discarded it because he had not "cleaned it".

Co-defendant, Stephanie Cahn, advised post Miranda, she and defendant, Roger Coleman III, conspired to leave the state and travel north. Cahn said she was leaving victim, A. Morris, because he was an abusive boyfriend. Cahn stated she told Coleman where Morris keeps his narcotics and allowed Coleman to take the narcotics while the two of them were inside the apartment, together, earlier in the day. Cahn stated she and Coleman looked for the money inside the apartment but did not find it. Cahn advised she informed Morris that she was not going to drive the Sonata to work because the engine was having issues and made arrangements for her mother to drive her. Cahn did this so it would not be suspicious to Morris when he saw the Sonata in the driveway upon returning home from work. several times. The defendant also held a knife to the neck of the victim and made threats that if she reported the incident to law enforcement he would kill the victim and her family.

The victim stated that she was putting [REDACTED] children to bed. The victim said one of the children was complaining and did not have wishes to go to sleep. The defendant went inside and spanked the child on the buttocks with his hand approximately three times. The victim stated she expressed concerns to the defendant because she believed that spanking [REDACTED] for not wanting to go to bed was excessive.

An argument ensued between the victim and the defendant on how the children should be disciplined. The victim then said the defendant began pushing her and slinging her around the room. The defendant then pushed the victim to the ground and was pinning her to the ground so she could not get up. The defendant then began slapping the victim in the forehead and pulling her hair. The victim said the defendant then dragged her to the door frame and slammed her into the door frame. At some point during the altercation, the victim's head was slammed into the ground causing her to receive a contusion to the back side of her head.

The victim then proceeded to the children's bedroom while the defendant was packing items to leave the residence. The defendant then entered the bedroom and held a knife to the victim's neck and stated if she told law enforcement he would kill her and her family.

The victim completed a sworn written statement form.

The victim and the defendant are currently married and live together in the residence as a family unit, and have two children in common.

The victim did have a small lump on the back of her head which I observed by feeling with my hand.

I attempted to contact the defendant on the defendant's phone, which the defendant took after the altercation. The phone was not answered and went straight to voice mail.
