[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

On 08/07/2018, at approximately 2046 hours, I responded to the Victoria's Secret located at 300 Hollywood Blvd. in Mary Esther, FL., in reference to a retail theft. Upon my arrival, I made contact with the reporting party identified as

stated two female subjects entered the Victoria's Secret at approximately 1930 hours. She advised one of the females had a Dillard's bag and began to place Victoria's Secret merchandise into the Dillard's bag. She advised she subject placed six jackets, two backpacks, and five pairs of pants into the bag. Rodriguez stated all the items were Pink brand and were valued at \$989.35. She stated the subjects then left the store and fled the area.

described the female who stole the items to me as a black female, approximately 5'3" tall, medium build, in her early twenties, with a short hairstyle. She stated the subject was last seen wearing a grey shirt and blue jeans. stated the subject was a female, however, had the overall appearance that was consistent with a male.

At approximately 0242 hours, I received information from Investigator Jennings that the female subject was currently in custody and she had confessed to the theft at Victoria's Secret. The female subject was identified as Tyra Booker who is the defendant in this case, Jennings stated the defendant was encountered during a separate theft investigation by Deputy Boyette. Deputy Boyette made contact with the defendant who was in possession of several clothing items which appeared new with the tags remaining attached to the items. Deputy Boyette interviewed the defendant who admitted the items had been stolen from several different locations throughout Okaloosa County, Deputy Boyette then placed the defendant under arrest and seized the items.

Investigator Jennings stated he also conducted a post-Miranda interview with the defendant and gathered further information. He stated the defendant admitted to stealing some of the items from the Victoria's Secret inside the REPORT NO: OCSO18ARR008506

Santa Rosa Mall. He advised five pairs of pants, two shirts, and two jackets were recovered and all the items were Pink

I collected a description of the defendant from Investigator Jennings and Deputy Boyette and found the defendants description to match the description of the female subject Rodriguez had described.

As a result of the above-cited investigation, I have probable cause to believe and do believe the defendant, Tyra Booker, did violate F.S.S. 812.014.2c grand theft over \$300 under \$20,000. This offense did occur in Okaloosa County, FL where I am a sworn law enforcement Deputy.
