Between the dates of September 1, 2018 and November 14, 2018, the defendant, Margaret McMahan Wolthers (primary teacher), willfully abused 3 autistic juvenile victims identified as [redacted] (10 years old) [redacted] (8 years old) and [redacted] (8 years old) multiple times by committing the following acts:

The defendant intentionally and maliciously blew a whistle within 7 inches of the [redacted] ear. This was done while holding the victim's arms down keeping him from protecting himself by covering his ears. Victim [redacted] has "Low Sensory Threshold" (ears) and wears earphones to protect him from the pain of loud noises. The defendant was aware of this condition and developed and signed a plan outlining this child disability and actions in place to protect him. The defendant has also threatened to use the whistle on [redacted] on numerous occasions to correct his behavior. [redacted] was interviewed and was able to disclose the defendant did commit this offense.

The defendant intentionally placed all 3 victims in her classroom bathroom on separate occasions, individually, with the door closed and the lights off. This was done as a punishment to the victims when they misbehaved. These victims were not provided any supervision while in the bathroom, and without the lights on this room was pitch black. On one occasion, the defendant put the victim [redacted] in the bathroom with the light off and door closed for approximately ninety minutes, this was witnessed by Napoli. Napoli reported if the victims turned the lights on or opened the door the defendant would extend the time the victim had to stay in the bathroom. [redacted] were interviewed about this offense and they confirmed the defendant did commit this offense.

On November 14, 2018, Witnesses (classroom aides), Hunter King (26 years old), Christa Bass (32 years old), and Joseph Napoli (25 years old), provided sworn written statements stating they have observed these offenses multiple times in the classroom. Napoli stated these offenses occurred 2-3 times a week during the 3 months he was employed at the school. King witnessed these offenses 2-3 times and Bass witnessed the whistle incident once. The witnesses reported the victims would scream and cry when they were placed into the bathroom. It was also reported [redacted] would "cringe" in pain when the whistle was blown in his ear.

On December 11, 2018, the victim's parents also completed sworn Affidavits of Complaint and stated they did not condone this abuse in the classroom and the victims Behavioral Intervention Plans (BIP) were not followed.
