[ STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE ]

Your Affiant's investigation is based on his observations and interviews of the victim, witness, and defendant.

On April 5, 2019, Nathan Wangerin entered Regions Bank, 1248 N Eglin Parkway, Shalimar, Florida. While inside the bank, he requested to open an account. During the process, he threatened to strike the manager, Benjamin Longmore. Eventually, he grabbed an envelope and demanded that Longmore fill it with \$10,000. After the demand, the employee fled into a safe area. While the employees were gone, he rummaged through the desk in an adjacent office and stole thermal plastic laminating pouches. Wangerin refused to listen to the commands of responding law enforcement officers, who had to subdue him by TASER. He continued to resist until he was placed in handcuffs.

Law enforcement first received this call when Regions employees called about Wangerin's odd behavior. As law enforcement was responding, Regions employees activated a hold-up alarm and notified law enforcement about a robbery in progress. They stated that Wangerin demanding money and threatening to strike an employee.

Your Affiant was the first law enforcement officer to arrive on scene. Your Affiant confronted Wangerin as he was walking out of an area that did not appear open to the public. Wangerin refused to listen to your Affiant's commands numerous times and became agitated with your Affiant. After numerous attempts to gain his compliance verbally, your Affiant deployed his TASER, forcing Wangerin to the ground. Wangerin tensed his body, flailed his legs, and continued to pull away from your Affiant and other law enforcement officers as they were placing him in handcuffs.

During verbal interviews and sworn written statements, Vivica Aaron and Martha Finn said that Wangerin came into the bank looking to open a loan. Both Aaron and Finn noted that he was behaving strangely before being referred to Longmore.

During a verbal interview and sworn written affidavit, Longmore stated that Wangerin came into the business asking to open an account. During the process, he told Longmore that he was going to hit him because his name sounded like he was a homosexual. This threat put Longmore in fear of being struck. As the process continued, Wangerin handed Longmore an envelope demanding that he put \$10,000 in the envelope. The witnesses corroborated the victim's statement in verbal interviews and sworn written statements.

During a search incident to arrest, thermal laminating pouches were found on Wangerin's person. The investigation determined that he had stolen thermal laminating pouches after his confrontation with Longmore. This office supplies is valued at \$10.

During a recorded verbal interview post Miranda, Wangerin admitted to going to the bank believing that he would get \$100,000 for free. He admitted to getting agitated with employees, but claimed that he could not remember what he said. He said that he did not listen to law enforcement commands because he believed law enforcement was there for another issue.

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Based on the above information, your Affiant has reason to believe and does believe that the defendant, Nathan Edward Wangerin, violated Florida State Statute 812.13(2c): Attempted Robbery Without a Weapon, 784.011: Assault, 843.02: Resisting an Officer Without Violence, and 812.014(3a): Petit Theft under \$100. These offenses occurred in Okaloosa County, Florida, where your Affiant is a sworn law enforcement officer.
