On May 8, 2019, I arrived at 1096 Beal Parkway, Ft. Walton Beach, Florida, regarding a warrant service in which Vinny Antonio Melo was identified as the DEFENDANT and Nicole Lee McAndrew was identified as the CODEFENDANT.

Sgt. Topolski observed Melo (driver's seat) and McAndrew (front passenger seat) in a vehicle in the parking lot. Sgt. Topolski believed McAndrew to be another person who had an active warrant. McAndrew was confirmed as not the person of interest. During the brief contact with McAndrew, the odor of marijuana was smelled emanating from the vehicle.

During a probable cause search of the vehicle, the following items were located: two (2) loaded firearms (center console), electronic scale with green leafy substance on it (center console), green leafy material (center console cup holder), a marijuana grinder (center console cup holder), ten (10) individually packaged plastic bags with crystalline substance inside an Altoids container (driver seat rear pouch), a brown backpack with additional narcotics (right rear passenger seat), and a shotgun concealed in the trunk.

The brown backpack contained two (2) small plastic bags with a crystalline substance contained within it and another small plastic bag with a white powdery substance. The backpack also contained several dozen empty plastic bags consistent with the size and style of the bags containing the controlled substances located in the same bag.

A field test of the crystalline substance contained in one (1) of the ten (10) individual plastic bags yielded a presumptive positive result for the presence of Methamphetamine (total weight of approximately 4 grams). A field test of the crystalline substance found inside the backpack yielded a presumptive positive result for the presence of methamphetamine (approximately 3.5 grams). A field test of the white powdery substance yielded a presumptive positive result for the presence of cocaine (approximately 3.3 grams).

Post Miranda, Melo advised McAndrew showed him the methamphetamine and cocaine she found approximately 3-4 days ago. Melo admitted to taking the narcotics and placing them in one of the compartments in the brown backpack which he admitted ownership of. Melo said he was going to get rid of the narcotics but forgot about them. Melo admitted the electronic scale was used to measure the weight of marijuana purchased by McAndrew to make sure she did not get cheated.

Each of the ten (10) small individually packaged plastic bags containing approximately 0.4 grams of methamphetamine. These bags were located inside of an Altoids can. The Altoids can was located in a pouch on the driver seat where Melo was seated and the vehicle was registered to Melo. Based on my training and experience, drug users do not package narcotics for personal use in this manner.

The loaded firearms (semi-automatic pistol and revolver) were located inside the center console, on or about Melo's person, and in an unclipped holster within immediate reach. The firearms were located and encased in a manner where they were readily accessible as if concealed on his person.

Based on the above, your Affiant has probable cause to believe Vinny Lee Melo violated Florida State Statute 790.07(2): Use of firearm during the commission of a felony, Florida State Statute 893.13(1)(a)(1): Possession of Methamphetamine with intent to Distribute, Florida State Statute 893.13(6)(a): Possession of Cocaine, and Florida State Statute 893.147: Possession of Paraphernalia.

This offense occurred in Okaloosa County where your Affiant is a sworn law enforcement officer.



[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

On May 8, 2019, I arrived at 1096 Beal Parkway, Ft. Walton Beach, Florida, regarding a warrant service in which Nicole Lee McAndrew was identified as the DEFENDANT and Vinny Antonio Melo was identified as the CO-DEFENDANT.

Sgt. Topolski observed Melo (driver's seat) and McAndrew (front passenger seat) in a vehicle in the parking lot. Sgt. Topolski believed McAndrew to be another person who had an active warrant. McAndrew was confirmed as not the person of interest. During the brief contact with McAndrew, the odor of marijuana was smelled emanating from the vehicle.

During a probable cause search of the vehicle, the following items were located: two (2) loaded firearms (center console), electronic scale with green leafy substance on it (center console), green leafy material (center console cup holder), a marijuana grinder (center console cup holder), ten (10) individually packaged plastic bags with crystalline substance inside an Altoids container (driver seat rear pouch), a brown backpack with additional narcotics (right rear passenger seat), and a shotgun concealed in the trunk.

The brown backpack contained two (2) small plastic bags with a crystalline substance contained within it, another small plastic bag with a white powdery substance, and a green leafy substance inside of a mason jar.

A field test of the crystalline substance contained in one (1) of the ten (10) individual plastic bags yielded a presumptive positive result for the presence of Methamphetamine (total weight of approximately 4 grams). A field test of the crystalline substance found inside the backpack yielded a presumptive positive result for the presence of methamphetamine (approximately 3.5 grams). A field test of the white powdery substance yielded a presumptive positive result for the presence of cocaine (approximately 3.3 grams). A field test of the green leafy material inside of the Mason jar yielded a presumptive positive result for the presence of Tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) (approximately 46 grams). A field test of the green leafy material contained inside the cup yielded a presumptive positive result for the presence of Tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) (less than 1 gram).

Post Miranda, McAndrew admitted to possession of the marijuana contained within the cup and the Mason jar. The marijuana grinder was also found in the cup as well. McAndrew stated she found the methamphetamine and cocaine approximately 3-4 days ago and gave it to Melo. McAndrew admitted she believed the substances to be cocaine when giving it to Melo. McAndrew said "we both use that bag" relating to use of the brown backpack.

The loaded firearms (semi-automatic pistol and revolver) were located inside the center console, on or about McAndrew's person, and in an unclipped holster within immediate reach. The firearms were located and encased in a manner where they were readily accessible as if concealed on her person.

Based on the above, your Affiant has probable cause to believe Nicole Lee McAndrew violated Florida State Statute 790.07(2): Use of firearm during the commission of a felony, Florida State Statute 893.13(6)(a): Possession of a Controlled Substance (Methamphetamine), Florida State Statute 893.13(6)(a): Possession of Cocaine, Florida State Statute 893.13(6)(a): Possession of Marijuana greater than 20 grams, and Florida State Statute 893.147: Possession of Paraphernalia.

These offenses occurred in Okaloosa County where your Affiant is a sworn law enforcement officer.
