

[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

On July 13, 2019, at approximately 0430 hours, the Defendant, Eugene Quentin Bradley, violated FSS 782.04.1a – Murder, by shooting the Victim, Christopher Eugene Black, three times with a firearm.

The Defendant confronted the Victim after seeing him talking to his girlfriend, Witness Salazar. Witnesses heard the

Victim state that Salazar only asked him for a cigarette. The Defendant then said "I'm going to go ask her and that there would be problems if one of them lied." The Defendant then followed the Victim back outside to the covered carport. The Defendant returned back inside and was witnessed shaking his head. He then returned to the carport where a physical altercation occurred between the Defendant and Victim. During the altercation, the Defendant shot the Victim three times killing him. The Defendant was also wounded in the left arm by one of the shots. This incident occurred at 671 Blackstone Road, Mary Esther, Florida.

The crime scene was processed and multiple items of evidentiary value were collected. Blood located on the front walkway leading to the front door was collected and submitted to FDLE for analysis. The FDLE analysis indicates the blood was the Defendants. Blood located under the carport where the Victim's body was located was also collected and submitted to FDLE for analysis. The analysis indicates the blood belonged to the Defendant. Gunshot residue was collected from the Victim and Defendant and submitted to RJ Lee group for analysis. This analysis located GSR on both hands of the Victim, and on the right hand of the Defendant.

Witness, Tara Pulley, who in a sworn statement stated: Bonner, the Defendant, and she, were hanging out in the living room of the residence and smoking Methamphetamine while the Victim was moving his belonging into the main residence. While the Victim was outside, he was approached by Salazar which was witnessed by the Defendant. When the Victim came back into the residence, the Defendant confronted the Victim and demanded to know what Salazar asked him. The Victim replied "A cigarette." She heard the Defendant tell the Victim, "I'm going to go ask her and that there would be problems if one of them lied." The Defendant walked out of the front door and talked to Salazar and the Victim walked out of the side door. The Defendant came back into the residence, shook his head, and walked back outside. Seconds later, she heard a female scream and then approximately five to six gunshots. Bonner went outside and the Defendant, Salazar, and he, left in a gold SUV. Hardie, Hardie's son, and Pulley, left the residence. As they were leaving, she saw the Victim lying on the ground asking for help. She called 911 using her cellular phone.

Witness, Coshua Bonner, stated in a sworn statement that the Defendant, Salazar, and he, had been out earlier that night selling illegal narcotics. At one point during the night, they drove to the residence listed above and sold the females inside illegal narcotics. They left and later came back to the residence where the Defendant, Pulley, and he, were hanging out in the living room of the residence and smoking Methamphetamine. The Victim was carrying things into the residence. While the Victim was outside, the Victim was approached by Salazar which was witnessed by the Defendant. When the Victim came back into the residence, the Defendant confronted the Victim and demanded to know what Salazar asked him. The Victim replied "A cigarette." The Defendant walked out of the front door and talked to Salazar and The Victim walked out of the side door. The Defendant came back into the residence, shook his head, and walked back outside. Approximately five seconds later, he heard a "scuffle" and female scream outside. He then heard approximately five to six gunshots. After the gunshots, he exited the residence and observed the Defendant coming from the area of the carport holding his head. He helped the Defendant to the vehicle, put him in the front passenger seat, and drove him to the hospital. After dropping them off at the hospital, he drove the Defendant's vehicle to 701 Shady Lane, Fort Walton Beach, Florida, and parked the vehicle behind this residence which belongs to the Defendant's father.

Witness, Shawna Hardie stated in a sworn verbal and written statement that: The Defendant arrived at her residence with Coshua Bonner and had been there for approximately fifteen minutes prior to her going to lay down with her three year old son. She was later awoken by a female screaming and heard multiple gunshots. As she grabbed her child to get him to safety, she heard the Victim yelling for help.

Witness, Selena Salazar, stated during a recorded interview that: She was with her boyfriend, the Defendant, in his vehicle driving around and stopped at the Victim's house. She went to the vehicle to get cigarettes and she thinks the Defendant assumed she left to get cigarettes. While she was in the vehicle she heard about 4 gunshots. The Defendant then came running to the vehicle. The Defendant was bleeding so she got him a towel out of the vehicle and placed on his head. Bonner then drove the Defendant to the hospital. Later when questioned by Investigator's, Salazar refused to cooperate or answer questions.

The Defendant was interviewed in a non-custodial manner at the hospital. The Defendant stated he had been in the hospital for the past six days due to his arm being broken from being hit by a car. The Defendant was then advised of his Miranda protection and stated he did not know what happened and refused to answer any further questions.

An autopsy was conducted at the office of the District 1 Medical Examiner. The report of the autopsy states:

Cause of death: Gunshot wound of abdomen.
