[ STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE ]

On November 19, 2019 at approximately 2248 hours, the Defendant, **CARISSA L. PARKER** violated Florida State Statute 777.03(1) - Accessory after the fact by driving the suspected shooter [REDACTED] to 888 Culp Avenue, Apartment 4, Fort Walton Beach, Florida during which the shooting and subsequent unlawful killing of the victim occurred. Through law enforcement resources [REDACTED] After the homicide was committed, the defendant assisted suspected shooter by driving the suspected shooter away from the scene of the crime with the intent to avoid detention, arrest, and punishment by law.

Between November 19, 2019, at 2348 hours and November 20, 2019, at 0009 hours, the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office received multiple 911 calls in the immediate vicinity of 888 Culp Avenue. All of the 911 calls reported multiple gunshots and a male screaming for help. Additionally, eye witnesses at the scene described a skinny black male with dreads armed with a revolver firearm.

Deputies arrived to the scene and discovered the victim deceased from an apparent gunshot wound to the head.

During the course of this investigation the following information was gathered; additional witnesses reported hearing gunshots and observed at least one male running westbound in the parking area of 888 Culp Avenue, away from the crime scene. The male, described as tall and skinny, entered the passenger side of a sedan vehicle parked on the east side of 312 Carmel Drive. The additional witness statements and observations were made during the time frame the multiple 911 calls were placed.

As part of its investigation, law enforcement obtained home security video footage from an address on Carmel Drive. This camera faces south and captures Culp Avenue. This video footage depicted the suspect vehicle arrive on Culp Avenue, and park on the shoulder of the east side of 312 Carmel Drive. This was on November 19, 2019 at approximately

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2342 hours, approximately 6 minutes before the first 911 call was received. At approximately 2349 hours (one minute after the first 911 call was received), the suspected shooter is seen traveling north on Culp Avenue and entered the passenger side of the vehicle before the vehicle departed the scene. The home security footage is also corroborated by witness statements and the multiple 911 calls.

On December 6, 2019 at approximately 1530 hours, [REDACTED] were interviewed by law enforcement and assisted law enforcement in its investigation by making a controlled phone call to the Defendant.

The following information was obtained from the controlled phone call: the Defendant [REDACTED] The Defendant admitted to using [REDACTED] vehicle, described as a [REDACTED] sedan to drive the suspected shooter to the Victim's residence, on the night of the homicide. The vehicle the Defendant admitted to possessing and driving to the scene of the homicide is visually similar to the vehicle depicted on the home security footage from Carmel Drive. The Defendant advised she detailed the ongoing issues with the Victim to the suspected shooter while driving to the Victim's residence. Once the Defendant and suspected shooter arrived on Culp Avenue, the Defendant advised the suspected shooter brandished a firearm, exited the vehicle, approached the Victim's residence and "took it upon himself to do whatever he wanted to do." Roberts asked the Defendant "What made him think it was ok to jump out of the car and shoot him?" The Defendant responded, "he pulled out a gun, [she] was terrified. That is when things escalated." The Defendant stated the suspected shooter has continued to threaten her since the homicide. [REDACTED] specifically asked the Defendant, "So he thinks you told them something about shooting him?" The Defendant replied, "Yes." The Defendant admitted to driving the suspected shooter to Pensacola, Florida, which is approximately one hour away from the location of the homicide.

The following information was obtained from the December 06, 2019, interview with [REDACTED] At approximately 0102 hours on November 20, 2019, the Defendant arrived at [REDACTED] residence in Pensacola, Florida, where [REDACTED] was located. The Defendant appeared upset and distraught and told [REDACTED] that the Victim "was gone." [REDACTED] took the Defendant's statement to mean the Victim was deceased. It is important to note the Defendant admitted knowledge of the Victim's death within approximately one and a half hours of the homicide.

Based upon the information obtained throughout the course of the investigation including but not limited to: video surveillance footage, 911 calls, witness statements, as well as information obtained from and statements made by the Defendant during the December 06 controlled telephone call, the Defendant knew the Victim was deceased and knew the cause of the Victim's death (gunshot). Finally, the Defendant admitted to driving herself and the suspected shooter to the Victim's residence on the date and time of the actual homicide, observing the suspected shooter in possession of a firearm prior to the suspected shooter approaching the Victim's residence within minutes of the actual shooting and subsequent death of the Victim. At no time did the Defendant attempt to contact law enforcement despite knowing the Victim was deceased and shot by the suspected shooter. Conversely, the Defendant assisted the suspected shooter by driving the suspected shooter away from the scene of the crime with the intent to avoid detention, arrest, and punishment by law.

Based on my investigation, I have probable cause to believe and do believe, the Defendant, CARISSAL PARKER, willfully violated Florida State Statute 777.03(1) - Accessory after the fact. This incident occurred in Okaloosa County, Florida where I am a sworn law enforcement officer.
