[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

On November 19, 2019, at approximately 2248 hours, the Defendant, JORDAN E PHILLIPS aka "TG" violated Florida State Statute 782.04.1a – Murder, by shooting the victim, Edgar Jennings with a firearm.

Between November 19, 2019, at 2348 hours and November 20, 2019, at 0009 hours, the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office received multiple 911 calls in the immediate vicinity of 888 Culp Avenue Fort Walton Beach, Florida. All of the 911 calls reported multiple gunshots and a male screaming for help. Additionally, eyewitnesses at the scene described a skinny black male with dreads, a red bandanna covering his face, and armed with a revolver firearm running from the address above.

Deputies arrived at the scene and discovered the victim deceased from an apparent gunshot wound to the head.

During the course of this investigation, the following information was gathered; additional witnesses reported hearing gunshots and observed at least one male running westbound in the parking area of 888 Culp Avenue, away from the crime scene. The male, described as tall and skinny, entered the passenger side of a sedan vehicle parked on the east side of 312 Carmel Drive. The additional witness statements and observations were made during the time frame the multiple 911 calls were placed.

As part of its investigation, law enforcement obtained home security video footage from an address on Carmel Drive. This camera [REDACTED] captures Culp Avenue. This video footage depicted the suspect vehicle arrive on Culp Ave. and park on the shoulder of the east side of 312 Carmel Drive. This was on November 19, 2019, at approximately 2342 hours, approximately 6 minutes before the first 911 call was received. At approximately 2349 hours (one minute after the first 911 call was received), the suspected shooter is seen traveling north on Culp Avenue and entered the passenger

side of the vehicle before the vehicle departed the scene. The home security footage is also corroborated by witness statements and the multiple 911 calls.

On December 6, 2019, at approximately 1530 hours [redacted] and [redacted] were interviewed by law enforcement and assisted law enforcement in its investigation by making a controlled phone call to the Co-defendant, Carissa Parker.

The following information was obtained from the controlled phone call: the Co-defendant identified the defendant as "TG" (otherwise known as JORDAN E. PHILLIPS). The Co-defendant admitted to using [redacted] vehicle, described as a 2010 green Hyundai Sonata sedan to drive the suspected shooter to the Victim's residence, on the night of the homicide. The vehicle, the Co-defendant admitted to possessing and driving to the scene of the homicide is visually similar to the vehicle depicted on the home security footage from Carmel Drive. The Co-defendant advised she detailed the ongoing issues with the Victim to the defendant while driving to the Victim's residence. Once the Co-defendant and Defendant arrived on Culp Avenue, the Co-defendant advised the Defendant brandished a firearm, exited the vehicle, approached the Victim's residence, and "took it upon himself to do whatever he wanted to do." Roberts asked the Co-defendant "What made him think it was ok to jump out of the car and shoot him?" The Co-defendant responded, "he pulled out a gun, [she] was terrified. That is when things escalated." The Co-defendant stated the Defendant has continued to threaten her since the homicide. [redacted] specifically asked the Co-defendant, "So he thinks you told them something about shooting him?" The Co-defendant replied, "Yes." The Co-defendant admitted to driving the Defendant to Pensacola, Florida, which is approximately one hour away from the location of the homicide.

On 12/10/19, OCSO investigators re-interviewed the Co-defendant. Post Miranda, the Co-defendant advised she picked up the Defendant at his house in Pensacola, Florida and drove him around to sell narcotics. During the course of the evening, the Co-defendant explained her situation involving her child and the father of her child. The Defendant brandished a firearm and told the co-defendant "Where I am from, guys that put their hands on their children do not deserve to have them". The Defendant instructed the Co-defendant to drive him to the victim's house. Prior to arrival, the defendant took the Co-defendant's cell phone and turned it off along with his cellphone. The Co-defendant asked, "What about the shell casings?" the Defendant replied, "Don't worry my gun doesn't leave any of those." The Co-defendant described the firearm as small and black.

Cellphone records show the Co-defendant's cellphone not receiving any data from 2101 hours on 11/19/19 to 0031 hours on 11/20/19. The Defendant's cellphone records show his phone stopped reciving data from 2148 hours on 11/19/19 to 0015 hours on 11/20/19.

The Co-defendant advised she drove passed the victim's house, on Culp ave explaining and identifying the home. The Defendant exits the vehicle with the firearm in his hand and proceeds to the home. Moments later, the Co-defendant hears gunshots and the Defendant enters the passenger side of the vehicle. The Co-defendant drives back to Pensacola with the Defendant.

The defendant was identified by his phone number, 850-[redacted] listed in the co-defendant's phone as "TG". A law enforcement data search showed the phone number above registered to the defendant. A search of the defendant's Facebook friend's list shows the co-defendant are friends. The Co-defendant also identifies the Defendant as "Phillips TG" which is the same name the defendant uses as his Facebook profile.

Based upon the information obtained throughout the course of the investigation including but not limited to: video surveillance footage, 911 calls, witness statements, as well as information obtained from and statements made by the Co-defendant during the December 06 controlled telephone call. The Defendant had constructed a premeditated plan to effect the death of the victim.

Based on the above-stated facts I have reason to believe and do believe the Defendant, JORDAN E PHILLIPS, violated Florida State Statute 782.04.1a - Murder, the actions of the Defendant caused the demise of the Victim, which was a criminal act. This offense occurred in Okaloosa County, Florida, where I am a sworn Deputy Sheriff.
