[ STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE ]

Deputy Sheriff Chad Biernacki, hereinafter referred to as your Affiant, is a sworn and bonded law enforcement officer. Your Affiant is currently employed by the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office (OCSO), and has been so employed since November 2019. Your Affiant is currently assigned to the OCSO Field Services Division as a Deputy Sheriff. Your Affiant previously served as a Deputy Sheriff for 12 years with the Walton County Sheriff's Office. Your Affiant being duly sworn states as follows:

On March 15, 2020, your Affiant initiated a traffic stop of a green 1998 Subaru, bearing Florida registration Z987ILA, for having an expired registration. Specifically the registration had expired on November 03, 2019. The vehicle came to a complete stop in the parking lot 925 Beal Parkway, Fort Walton Beach, Okaloosa County, Florida.

Once the vehicle was stopped and Thomas M. MEARNS (Rear Passenger/Defendant) attempted to flee from the vehicle but was ordered to stop to which he complied. Jeremy T. SULLIVAN (Driver/Defendant) also attempted to exit the vehicle but complied with orders to remain inside the vehicle. The third occupant was identified as Jessica Y. FOSTER (Front Seat Passenger/Defendant).

When asked for a driver's license, SULLIVAN advised his license was suspended and this was confirmed via NCIC by OCSO Dispatch.

While speaking with SULLIVAN, MEARNS continuously made furtive movements in the back seat of the vehicle. MEARNS kept reaching into his waistband and into the rear cargo area of the vehicle.

After another law enforcement officer arrived on scene and based on the above, all of the Defendants were removed from the vehicle and placed into hand restraints.

Canine D/S Cutler Petersen arrived on scene and asked the Defendants if there was any methamphetamine, hemp, marijuana, cocaine or heroin inside the vehicle to which they stated there was not. D/S Petersen then utilized his certified narcotics detection Canine "Miro" to conduct a free air sniff of the vehicle's exterior. D/S Petersen informed your Affiant "MIRO" had rendered a positive canine alert for the odor of narcotics emitting from the vehicle.

During a probable cause search of the vehicle, the following contraband was located:

- One (1) black backpack containing SULLIVAN's wallet with credit cards bearing his name; One (1) digital scale (FTP Fentanyl); Approximately five (5) grams of suspected heroin (FTP); Two (2) green pills inscribed "S903" identified as suspected Alprazolam a schedule four controlled substance via pill identifier; Unknown green leafy substance.. The backpack was located on the rear passenger directly behind SULLIVAN.
- One (1) black sunglass case containing four (4) used syringes; One (1) glass pipe (FTP methamphetamine); Approximately nine (9) grams of suspected heroin (FTP); Approximately nine (9) grams of suspected methamphetamine (FTP); Approximately three (3) grams of suspected cocaine HCL (FTP); Eleven orange pills inscribed "AN/415" identified as Buprenorphine a schedule three controlled substance via pill identifier. This case was located at MEARNS' feet next to another glass smoking device (FTP methamphetamine).
- One (1) black and white coin purse containing approximately one (1) gram of suspected heroin; One (1) gram of suspected methamphetamine; One half of a green pill matching the above referenced Alprazolam pill; Unknown green

leafy substance. The coin purse was located in between FOSTER's seat and the center console.

- One (1) black purse containing assorted drug paraphernalia was located inside a larger brown purse at FOSTER's feet.

Post Miranda, SULLIVAN requested an attorney, MEARNES denied ownership of the contraband advising it belonged to SULLIVAN, and FOSTER denied ownership advising SULLIVAN should claim possession.

Based on the above, your Affiant has probable cause to believe Jeremy T. SULLIVAN violated Florida State Statutes 893.135.1c1: Trafficking in Heroin; 893.13.6a: Possession of Alprazolam; 322.34.10b1: DWLSR and 893.147.1: Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.
