[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

On March 2, 2020, Zachary MCKINNEY (Defendant) was arrested for the following: False Imprisonment, Child Abuse, Resisting Officer, Battery on Law Enforcement/Health Care Professional (3 counts). These incidents took place at two locations, 58 mile marker 1-10 and North Okaloosa Medical Center.

During the above listed date, a lawful traffic stop was initiated by Sergeant Jason Folley on a grey 2010 Dodge,

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bearing Florida registration [REDACTED] The stop was initiated based on the description given to the Okaloosa County Sheriffs Office via Crestview Police Department regarding a child custody/Baker Act.

During the roadside investigation, the driver, Zachary MCKINNEY (Defendant), refused to obey basic commands given by the deputies on scene such as, roll down the window, step out of the vehicle, and keep hands visible. MCKINNEY was also profusely sweating, had very constricted pupils, accompanied with rapid eye movement, and was complaining of thirst.

Based on the above information and officers' knowledge and experience, responding officers suspected Mckinney was under the influence of narcotics. Back-up officers responded and multiple attempts to gain compliance from MCKINNEY was attempted. Officers spoke to MCKINNEY in great length attempting to get MCKINNEY to obey commands. Various tactics were used to remove [REDACTED] (Victim) from the situation and into the safety of the responding officers. MCKINNEY refused to release the victim, even after concerns were raised about his health. Special Response Team made entry into the vehicle and detained MCKINNEY while gaining custody of [REDACTED] MCKINNEY used [REDACTED] (Victim), as a shield during his refusal to law enforcement commands. This was an intentional act that could be reasonably expected the victim could have been physically injured based on MCKINNEY's actions.

Upon final questioning at the NOMC, MCKINNEY refused to cooperate and Deputy Langer stated it was time to be transported to the jail due to screening refusal. In response, MCKINNEY began to scream and attempt to remove his cuffs. MCKINNEY was forcibly removed from the medical center by Deputy Langer and I. During the transport to the patrol vehicle, MCKINNEY kicked wildly and struggled against both deputies. MCKINNEY successfully kicked Deputy Langer multiple times and attempted to bite Deputy Langer. MCKINNEY also attempted to bite me. MCKINNEY successfully kicked me in the groin, and scratched my right forearm. With the assistance of backup, MCKINNEY was successfully transported to the Okaloosa County Jail.

Upon arrival to the Okaloosa County Jail, MCKINNEY was refused based on elevated vitals, and lethargic mannerisms. EMS was requested and MCKINNEY was transported to the North Okaloosa Medical Center for care. Upon arrival, MCKINNEY was placed in a room and a medical staff member retrieved MCKINNEY without assistance, and wheeled him into the CT room. During the scan, MCKINNEY attacked the medical staff member. MCKINNEY tried to choke the medical staff member and tried to prevent him from calling out for help by shoving his fingers into the medical staff members mouth. The medical staff member reported numerous injuries sustained to his face, neck, mouth, and abdomen. He will be providing a Sworn Written Affidavit regarding the battery when physically able. Sworn verbal statement collected at the time.

Based the above, I, Deputy Sheriff Hunter Russo, have probable cause to believe the Defendant, Zachary MCKINNEY, violated the following Florida State Statutes:

- 787.02.1b - False Imprisonment
- 827.04.2 - Child Abuse
- 843.02 Resisting Officer
- 784.07.2b Battery on Law Enforcement Officers (3 counts)

These instances occurred in Okaloosa County where I am a sworn and bonded law enforcement officer.
