[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

On 04/22/20 at about 1440 hours, I, Deputy Piaget and Deputy Gleneck, responded to ██████████ FWB, FL in reference to a a six year old juvenile who locked the adult out of the residence. The adult, identified as the DEFENDANT, TONI REID, ██████████ The DEFENDANT requested law enforcement assistance to gain access to her residence.

Myself and Deputy Gleneck entered the residence and immediately smelled a strong odor of feces and urine. I observed multiple piles of animal feces located all over the dark hardwood floor. I also observed a large amount of feces smeared all along the floor. The smeared feces had footprints where it appeared someone had walked through. Some of the dog feces appeared to have been there for some time as it had mold on it and was stuck to the floor. There were two large dogs roaming inside the residence.

The VICTIM'S room was observed with a large bare mattress laying on the bedroom floor. The mattress had a large hole in it down to the metal springs. The room was packed with dirty clothing, toys and trash that ran alongside the mattress where it covered almost the entire floor. I did not locate any pillows or linens for the mattress. The bedroom light was not in working order.

I located the VICTIM, who was sitting on a large amount of dirty laundry located in the DEFENDANT'S bedroom closet. There was animal feces located right in front of the closet doorway where the VICTIM was located. The

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smell of urine and feces was overwhelming in the bedroom. The walls appeared to be tarnished with filth in the bedroom.

The kitchen area was observed a large puddle of animal urine in front of the washer. A dirty towel was also placed in front of the washer. There were dirty dishes sitting along the side of the sink area with assorted older food still in the bowls. The stove had multiple knives which was within the VICTIM'S reach. Multiple chemicals was observed sitting on the kitchen counters. There was an abundance of flies throughout the residence. The bathroom across from the VICTIM'S bedroom was dirty and smelled of urine. Investigation revealed the VICTIM is not allowed to use this bathroom as it is non-functioning.

During my interaction with the VICTIM, I observed her scratching her vaginal area and buttocks from the outside of her pants. She also scratched her head and hair multiple times throughout the entirety of the investigation. While I was inside the residence I became covered in fleas. Fleas were also located on the VICTIM's clothing, hair, and person.

There was a large dog located in the DEFENDANT'S bedroom. There was a strong odor of urine and a multitude of flies were observed around the dog. The dog was covered in a blue sheet and trash and feces was observed around the dog. Dirty empty bowls was also observed sitting by the dog. The DEFENDANT stated the dog has not been moved since last Saturday. There was black mold located inside the bathtub in the DEFENDANT'S bathroom along with various items. There was an apparent heavy dirt ring that lined the inside of the tub. The toilet had fecal matter splattered all along the the side of the tank.

Post Miranda, the DEFENDANT claimed the animal feces was on floor for only a short period of time. She claimed the DEFENDANT had locked the dog door to the back door on yesterday's date preventing the dogs to be able to use the bathroom outside. When confronted about the feces that had been in the residence for a long period of time, the DEFENDANT stated she did not have time to clean up the current animal feces that was observed throughout the residence. The DEFENDANT stated she had a 17 year old dog that could not walk and was located in her bedroom. The DEFENDANT stated the dog sometimes defecates where he is laying due to his limited movement. The DEFENDANT claimed the VICTIM tears up her room and mattress and had busted the light to her room as well as the outside light. The DEFENDANT stated the VICTIM uses her bathroom to bathe. The DEFENDANT first stated to Deputy Gleneck the alternate bathroom was not in working order however later stated it was in working order for use.

During my interactions with the DEFENDANT she deflected any questions as to her failure to provide prudent care for the child by blaming the actions upon the child. The DEFENDANT displayed no concern or emotion when confronted with the fact the kid was being removed from her care by the Department of Children and Families and the Families First Network staff. The DEFENDANT's only concern seemed to be the arrest process so she could make arrangements for her dogs. The DEFENDANT accepted no responsibility for the condition of the residence other than stating she maintains a clean house.

The DEFENDANT willfully, through her own negligence, failed or omitted to provide the VICTIM with the care, supervision, and services necessary to maintain the VICTIM's physical or mental health as well as failed to make a reasonable effort to protect the VICTIM from abuse, neglect, or exploitation by another person.

Based on the above, your Affiant has probable cause to believe the DEFENDANT, TONI REID, did violate Florida State Statue 827.03.2d: Child Neglect Without Great Bodily Harm.
