Subject: Annual Review of Bias Based Policing - 2019

This report is provided in accordance with G.O. 2.06, CALEA 1.2.9d and CFA 2.08 for the Annual Review of Bias-Based Policing. Information documented in this report was derived from the research of agency forfeiture and seizure cases, traffic stop data, traffic citations, Subject Resistance Reports, and arrests. There were three documented citizen complaints which were thoroughly investigated and determined to be unfounded.

The review of forfeiture and seizure records found no correlation noted for any bias-based profiling; however the overall numbers were too low (6 total) to indicate a pattern. There was also no pattern or correlation noted between the number of Subject Resistance Reports and any deputy engaged in this activity. Research of data for deputies involved in traffic stop written warnings, citations issued, arrests, Notice to Appear (NTA), and warrants in relation to the demographics of a suspect were also unremarkable.
