[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

On 06/25/20 members of the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office Street Crimes Unit were conducting patrols in the area of Niceville, Florida. At approximately 2016 hours, I observed a Ford F-150 traveling west on John Sims Pkwy with an obstructed tag in violation of FSS 320.061. I conducted a traffic stop on the Ford F-150 bearing FL Tag IL95UA at the back entrance to Chick-Fil-A located at 1348 John Sims Pkwy E, Niceville, FL.

Contact was made with the driver and passenger/defendant (William Jason Adams). While conducting my traffic investigation, D/S T. Costantini arrived on scene with his trained narcotics detection K9 "Rocco" and conducted a free air sniff of the vehicle. I was advised by D/S T. Costantini that "Rocco" provided a positive alert to the presence of the odor of illegal narcotics emanating from the vehicle.

A subsequent search of the vehicle revealed the following:

- 1 clear bag wrapped in foil containing approximately 25 grams of suspected Fentanyl in the driver floorboards.
- 1 box of 41 full metal jacket rounds in the the driver floorboards.
- 1 black magnetic box with less than 1 gram of suspected Methamphetamine in the front passenger floorboards.
- 1 clear plastic bag with suspected Methamphetamine residue in the front center console.
- 1 suspected Methamphetamine pipe in the glove box.

All narcotics/paraphernalia were field tested utilizing Nark II Field Test Kits and yielded presumptive positive results for their suspected substances.

The defendant and driver were advised of their rights via a prepared Miranda statement. During my post Miranda interview the driver stated he had just picked the defendant up to go to the casino in Atmore, Alabama. The defendant provided the driver narcotics as payment for driving. As I activated my emergency lights the defendant threw items over into the driver side floorboards. The driver denied knowledge of the 25 grams of Fentanyl and ammunition, stating he believed these were the items the defendant discarded at the beginning of the traffic stop. The driver did also admit to having knowledge that the defendant is a known seller of illegal narcotics. The defendant admitted to having been holding the magnetic box but stated he believed it to be empty. The defendant admitted the driver had picked him up to go to the casino in Atmore, Alabama but denied ownership of the 25 grams of Fentanyl and ammunition.

A Criminal History was run on the defendant which revealed 11 prior felony convictions.

Based on the aforementioned facts and investigation, I find probable cause to believe William Jason Adams violated FSS 893.13.6a Possession of a Controlled Substance Without a Prescription, to wit methamphetamine, FSS 893.135.1c4a Traffic in Fentanyl 4g or more, FSS 893.147.1 Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and FSS 790.23.1a Possession Weapon/Ammo by Convicted Felon. These offenses occurred in Okaloosa County, where I am a sworn law enforcement officer.

A subsequent search of the vehicle revealed the following:

- 1 box of 41 full metal jacket rounds in the the driver floorboards.
- 1 black magnetic box with less than 1 gram of suspected Methamphetamine in the front passenger floorboards.
- 1 clear plastic bag with suspected Methamphetamine residue in the front center console.
- 1 suspected Methamphetamine pipe in the glove box.

A subsequent search of the defendant revealed the following:

I envelope with the passengers name which was folded in half to contain suspected Methamphetamine located in the defendant's front left pocket.

The top half of the envelope folded to contain suspected Fentanyl located in the defendant's wallet.

All narcotics/paraphernalia were field tested utilizing Nark II Field Test Kits and yielded presumptive positive results for their suspected substances.

The defendant was advised of his rights via prepared Miranda statement. During my post Miranda interview the defendant stated he had just picked the passenger up to go to the casino in Atmore, Alabama. The passenger provided the defendant the narcotics located on his person as payment for driving. As I activated my emergency lights the passenger threw items over into the driver side floorboards. The defendant denied knowledge of the Methamphetamine pipe however, did admit to being a narcotics user. The defendant also denied knowledge of the 25 grams of Fentanyl and ammunition, stating he believed these were the items the passenger discarded at the beginning of the traffic stop. The defendant did also admit to having knowledge that the passenger is a known seller of illegal narcotics.

Based on the aforementioned facts and investigation, I find probable cause to believe John Nance Underdahl violated FSS 893.13.6a Possession of a Controlled Substance Without a Prescription, to wit methamphetamine, FSS 893.13.6a Possession of a Controlled Substance Without a Prescription, to wit Fentanyl, and FSS 893.147.1 Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. These offenses occurred in Okaloosa County, where I am a sworn law enforcement officer.
